

## FAREWELL GAME: OUR WISH UPON A STAR



All participants



10 min



One star should be cut off and given to each of the participants. Now, ask the participants if they have heard of the poem Star light, star bright, first star I see tonight, I wish I may I wish I might, have the wish I wish tonight. Explain that children are encouraged to say this and then make a wish when they see a glimmer of the first star at night. Then encourage the participants to think of a wish they have for the team if their time together has shown them a glimmer of hope. Now, pass out the stars and invite the participants to write down their wishes on the stars. When they are finished, ask them to stand up in a circle. Tell the participants their sky is now the floor in front of them. Ask each participant to approach and lay down their star stating their wish out loud. Finish the activity with appraisal applause and thank everyone for their participation and great wishes.



Use this exercise to close the module in a positive, motivational way, making the participants feel and think about endless possibilities rather than impossibilities.
