

TASK: MY ENTREPRENEURIAL DNA



Individual work, discussion in plenum



20 minutes (10+10)



The assistant trainer puts/sticks 2 FC papers on the wall, one next to the other. On FC papers, participants will paste their filled A4 paper when they complete the task.

The lead trainer asks participants to think about their characteristics and personal traits in the next 10 minutes, to describe them on A4 paper and to determine which type of entrepreneur they belong to, i.e. what kind of entrepreneurial DNA they have.

After they finish, they need to stamp their descriptions on the FC papers provided for that purpose. Then the assistant trainer will determine in which part of the room a certain type of entrepreneur should sit, and the participants will be transferred to that part of the room that is intended for this type of entrepreneur. Participants who have identified themselves as a combination of two types can sit where they feel they mostly belong to.

After this, the lead trainer should note how their entrepreneurial choices brought them to such a group they are now in, and then begins a brief discussion of the issues:

- Are you satisfied with the company around you?
- Are you scared of the competition that is around you?
- Would you like to belong to some other type of entrepreneur and why, and what do you lack to belong to the desired type of entrepreneur?



Participants will gain an overview through this task on their own characteristics and understand which type of entrepreneur they mostly belong to.



FC paper (2 sheets next to each other on the wall), A4 paper, crepe tape
